Submittal Checklist for Multi-Family and Commercial Development

All applications for a building permit for construction of multi-family, commercial, and non-residential development shall be accompanied by the following information, unless the Building Official determines the requirement is not necessary to obtain compliance with the City's codes:

 Payment of an upfront Plan Review Fee as may be required by the Building Official.
 Two (2) copies of Construction Documents of sufficient clarity to indicate the location, nature, and extent of the work proposed and showing in detail that it will conform to the laws, ordinance, rules and regulations of the City.
 Two (2) copies of a Site Plan, drawn to scale and in accordance with an accurate boundary line survey, including the following information: North arrow Outline and dimensions of the property boundaries Size and location of all new construction and existing structures on the site Distance from lot lines to all new construction and existing structures Distance between any existing structures and the proposed structure Established street grades and proposed finished grades Location of all parking areas and other improvements to be constructed in conjunction with the development
 Two (2) copies of fire protection system shop drawings containing all information necessary to verify compliance with IBC Chapter 9- Fire Protection Systems.
 Two (2) copies of diagrams of sufficient detail to show the means of egress, including the path of the exit discharge to the public way and, when required, the number of occupants to be accommodated on every floor, and in all rooms and spaces.
 Two (2) descriptions of the exterior wall envelope in sufficient detail to determine compliance with adopted codes, including flashing, intersections with dissimilar materials, corners, end details, control joints, intersections at roof, eaves or parapets, means of drainage, water-resistive membrane and details around openings, and manufacturers installations instructions for wall penetrations, etc.
 Washington State Energy Code form including information on window schedule, insulation values, mechanical systems, etc.
 Geotechnical Report containing all information necessary to verify compliance with IBC Chapter 18- Geotechnical Investigations.
 Environmental submittals for certain construction projects or when located in floodplains, geologically hazardous areas, wetlands or other critical and shoreline areas protected by State law.

 Verification of water availability through application to the Public Works Department. If public water is not available, then a copy of the Skamania County Community Development Department's (509-427-3900) Water Availability Verification (WAV).
 Verification of sewer availability through application to the Public Works Department. If public sewer is not available, then a copy of the Public Works Director's permission to install septic system and the Skamania County Environmental Health Department's (509-427-3900) approval of the septic system design.
 Any other data or information required by the Building Official to aid review of the application for code compliance.
