PRESS RELEASE-SEWER IMPROVEMENTS ALONG ROCK CREEK DR.

Also called the 2021 Collection System Improvements – Phase 1, the sewer improvements contract along Rock Creek Drive is composed of two different City Projects. These projects include the Cascade Interceptor and Rock Creek Pump Station Project and the Rock Creek Stormwater Project. The Cascade Interceptor and Rock Creek Pump Station Project is funded by a \$1.6M Economic Development Administration (EDA) grant and a \$400k USDA RD (Rural Development) loan. The Rock Creek Stormwater Project is funded by the City budget, in the amount of \$180k.

In order to facilitate a smooth, safe, and efficient project, <u>SW Rock Creek Drive will have single lane</u> <u>closures from its intersection with Rock Creek Park Road to the Mill Pond Trailhead</u>. Additionally, <u>SW</u> <u>Vancouver Avenue may experience intermittent full closures</u>. These closures will occur during

contractor work hours, approximately 7:00a to 5:00p, Monday through Friday for the duration of the project. Local access will still be provided, as well as access for emergency services and school buses. Pedestrian access will be provided via a detour over the Fairground Bridge.

The project schedule currently shows <u>completion in August</u> <u>2022</u>. If possible, please consider using an alternate route to reach your destination to avoid delays to your trip.
